Edward & Glen have four children and they live in the village of Manzaze to the south of Dodoma. They wrest their living from the soil, and report that the main challenges for them have been unreliable rainfall and cash flow problems to purchase seeds and pesticides. They have received a female goat from the DSC, as part of the "Passing on the Gift" goat program. In order to receive a goat they needed to attend a training seminar where they learned about goat rearing, what to feed the goat and how to treat the goat for illnesses. The benefits they foresee are the possibility of selling kid goats as well as having some milk to feed their children.

They also see other advantages of the goat project. Their children are learning the discipline of caring for and feeding the goats regularly. In addition, the goat rearing group of families has learned to work together as a group, toward a common purpose.
